The Stone Soup Leadership Institute's **Global Blue Job Shadow Day 2026** is designed to build bridges between business, education and government leaders who want to design customized workforce development strategies for their communities. This one-hour hybrid event features communities in the U.S. and Portugal who are pioneers in the Blue Economy. Each community will create an in-person event and invite their leaders and young people to join in this transformational experience. Each community will feature speakers from their chosen pathway from business, government, education, and youth who will share their experiences, best practices and lessons learned. Together we will learn from each other and explore how we might engage others in this New Frontier to maximize the \$2.5 Trillion goal set at UNOC3 in June 2025.

The event will be an opportunity to announce any upcoming events, initiatives as well as a **Call to Action.** For example, at the Cronkite Awards for Climate Education in 2023 which were held at the State Capitol in Massachusetts, Connecticut, New Jersey and Hawaii, each of the award recipients announced initiatives, legislation and funding for their work in the coming year. To maximize this strategic opportunity, we will send a press release and invite local press to attend and report on the event - and the Call to Action.

The Stone Soup Leadership Institute's Job Shadow Day is a building block in our initiatives: <u>Case Studies</u> Developed in partnership with the San Francisco Chamber of Commerce in the early 90's, this program has impacted high school and community college students. Since 2020 we've tailored the program to guide students to sustainable workforce development opportunities with a **Green Job Shadow Day** and a **Blue Job Shadow Day**. The Institute is a global leader in developing sustainable workforce development initiatives that prepare multicultural youth to become leaders of their lives, and in their communities. Founded in 1997, the Institute collaborates with business, education, government, and community leaders to design customized workforce development initiatives. We've worked with Blue Economy communities on islands and coastal communities since 2018. Our educational tools, trainings, place/project- based learning programs build a sustainable workforce.
